## What we offer

Exclusive use of the Pavilion and Herb Garden between 11-4pm (inclusive of one hour either side for set up and pack down). The [Pavilion](#) is a bright, informal and contemporary space with access to the gardens on both sides. We are a dry hire venue, allowing you the creative freedom to tailor your party as your child wants.

Please bring in your own food and drink as well as all plates, glasses and cutlery. Please be eco-conscious when catering your party, choosing reusable options where possible and if not, compostable items. We have bins for recycling and general waste that will be provided for you, but if you generate more than two bags of waste, we ask you to take this off site with you. You are welcome to decorate the room as you like, as long as nothing is stuck to the walls with strong adhesive. There 30 chairs and 12 tables in the room as well as two sinks with access to drinking water. Toilets, baby change and a buggy park are located just opposite. We ask that you leave the room in the same clean and tidy state that you find it in. There will be charges for any cleaning incurred or if the room is not ready to be locked at 4pm.

Please note, this is a self-led hire and does not include staffing from the Museum.
